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Notice to Worth Township Residents

RE: Sewer Connection Process

Dear Resident:

Now that the installation of the Worth Township municipal sewer system is almost complete, it is time to start preparing to connect your residence or business to the municipal sewer itself.

The applications and permits required to proceed for your sewer connection include:

1. Worth Township - Sewer Connection Permit
2. Sanilac County Health Department - Endorsement to Proceed

Once you have obtained the above two permits you may proceed to the County Court House and obtain:

3. County Court House (Construction and Land Use Department) - Plumbing Permit

Sanilac County Health Department will need to verify that all the sewage is directed to the municipal sewer system and that all septic tanks are properly abandoned. Much of the process in our department will be validated by administrative review or paper documentation. Required information that must be submitted by either the property owner or contractor installing the sewer lead, is as follows:

- A. Submittal of a contractor affidavit form
- B. A septage hauler pump-out receipt. The "Property Information" address as it was submitted on the Tank Abandonment Application form must be identified on the pump-out receipt
- C. An approved plumbing inspection

Periodic inspections will be conducted by the health department to assure the work documented by the required contractor affidavit, is complete and accurate.
